No fewer than 40,000 buildings are listed as of architectural or cultural significance, in addition to 200 conservation zones in historic towns and as many as twelve sites are on the UNESCO list of World Heritage monuments.

Much of this marvellously rich cultural heritage suffered grievously during the Communist years, but since the Velvet Revolution of 1989 enormous efforts have been made both by the government and private individuals to restore the Czech architectural and artistic patrimony.
